Who We Are

The Wakefield Interfaith Food Pantry has been serving Wakefield residents since 1982. Originally founded by members of the First Baptist Church, where it is still located, the food pantry became an interfaith effort, and is now guided by Board members representing the local congregations and the community at large.

The food pantry is also supported by many local schools, clubs, civic organizations, businesses, employee groups, and individuals, as well as by number of dedicated volunteers. It is truly a community-wide effort that reflects the caring spirit of the people of Wakefield.

Hours of Operation

The food pantry is open from 10:00-11:00 am every Tuesday and Thursday, except on major holidays.

Who is Eligible

Any Wakefield resident who is in need of food can come to the food pantry. The only requirement is proof of residence such as a drivers license, utility bill, or rent receipt. Those in need may come to the food pantry once a month. Grocery gift certificates for perishable foods are given at the initial visit, and then once every three months, as finances permit.

What We Offer

We offer a wide variety of non-perishable foods and, when available, paper goods, toiletries, and baby food. We also provide information about additional resources.

How to Help

Donations of non-perishable foods and cash are always needed and appreciated. Donations can be dropped off M,W,F 9-12 noon from September through mid-June, or call for an alternate time. Call for summer drop-off hours.
